## <u>Questions</u>

#### Without the Word of God, You Are Blind (1 Samuel 3:1-5; Deuteronomy 13:4; 1 Corinthians 2:14; Proverbs 29:18)

- Why was there "no frequent vision" in those days and why is that a bad thing?
- How can we hear from God? If we can't hear from God, what is typically the reason?
- What are some steps that you can take to be sure that you are getting a true vision for your life that comes from God?

# When God Speaks, He Expects Obedience (1 Samuel 3:10-14; John 8:47; John 10:3-4, 27; James 1:22)

- What should our response be when God speaks?
- What did God call Samuel to do and how did he respond?
- Can you think of an example in your own life where God called you to say or do something? How did you respond?

#### The Word of the Lord Is the Final Authority (1 Samuel 3:15-21; 2 Timothy 3:16; Hebrews 1:1-2)

- What was Eli's response to the judgment from the Lord passed down through Samuel?
- How can we be sure that we are believing and living the truth?
- How have you seen God's Word work in your own life over the years to teach, correct, and train you in righteousness?
